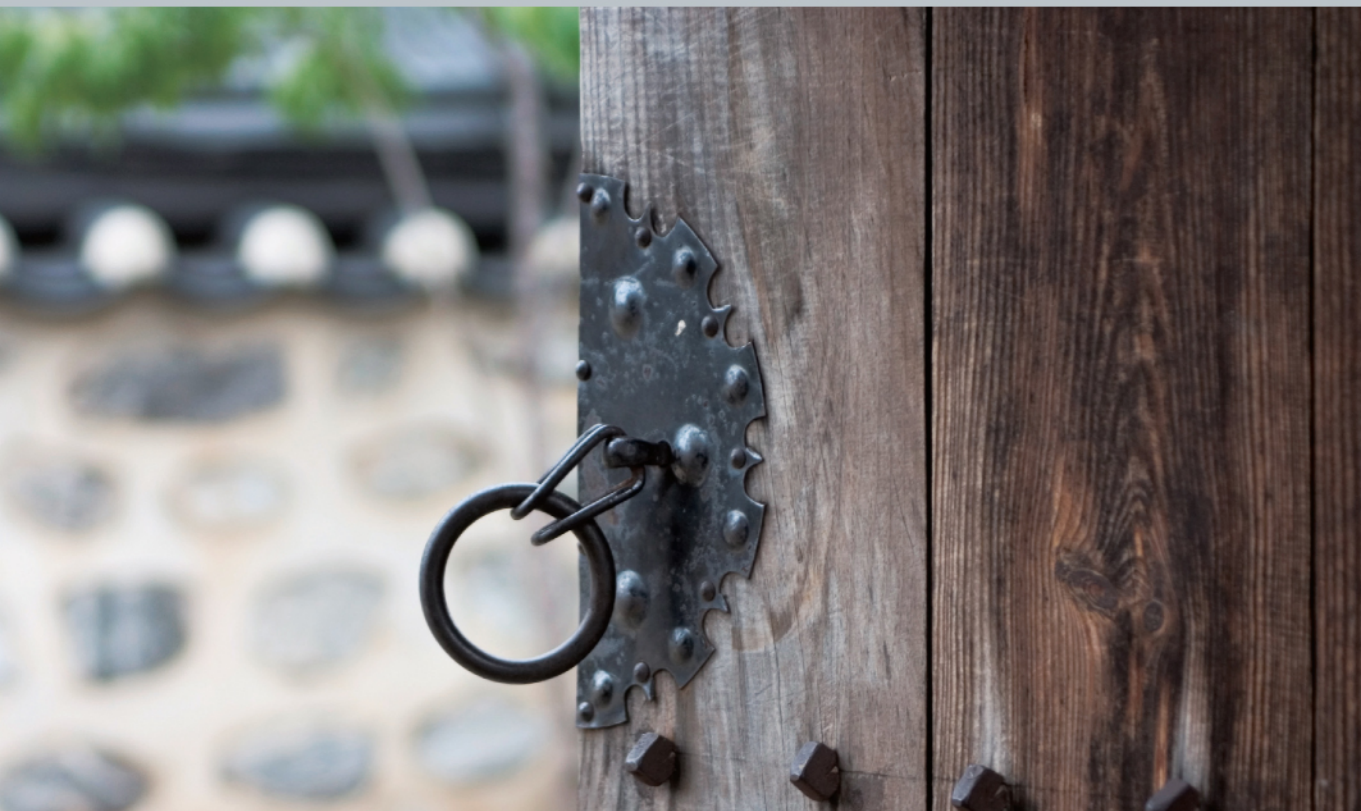

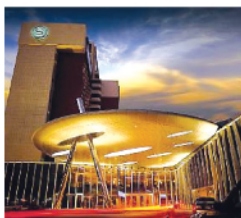

Currency

The unit of the Korean currency is the Won(₩). Coin denominations are ₩10, ₩50, ₩100, and ₩500. Banknotes are ₩1,000, ₩5,000, ₩10,000, and ₩50,000. The exchange rate is approximately USD1 to KRW 1,124.60 as of March, 2012.



Climate

Korea's climate is regarded as a continental climate in terms of temperature and a monsoonal climate in terms of precipitation. The climate of Korea is characterized by four distinct seasons: Spring, Summer, Fall and Winter.



VAT

Value-Added Tax (VAT) is levied on most goods and services at a standard rate of 10% and is included in the retail price. In tourist hotels, this 10% tax applies to rooms, meals, and other services and is included in the bill.

Delegates, expect those from countries who have visa exemption agreements with Korea, should apply to a Korean diplomatic mission in their country for visas prior to departure. Geography & Location of Korea
